



**Have you heard about how you can support Jewish education and reduce your state taxes at the same time?**

A new Georgia law allows you to redirect your state taxes to a scholarship fund for public school students who want to go to private school and can't afford it. The ALEF Fund is a School Scholarship Organization created by the Jewish Federation of Greater Atlanta to accept those redirected funds and award them to students who want to transfer from public school to Jewish day school or high school. You can redirect money you would have paid in state taxes to Rambam Atlanta at virtually no cost to you and with an easy three-step process!
